

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-01

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JUAN
BAUTISTA AMENDING SECTION 2-1-205 OF THE SAN JUAN
BAUTISTA MUNICIPAL CODE TO CHANGE THE TIME FOR ANNUAL
SELECTION OF MAYOR
AND MAYOR PRO TEMPORE**

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JUAN BAUTISTA HEREBY
ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. Section 2-1-205 of the San Juan Bautista Municipal Code hereby is amended to read as follows:

2-1-205 Choosing Mayor and Mayor ProTempore.

At the regular meeting in December of each year the City Council shall choose one of its members to serve as Mayor and one of its members to serve as Mayor Pro Tempore, each to serve until successors are chosen at the regular meeting in the following December.

SECTION 2. This ordinance and the various parts thereof are hereby declared to be severable. Should any part of this ordinance be declared by a court to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any other part that the part so declared.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall go into effect thirty (30) days after the date of its adoption.
