RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JUAN BAUTISTA APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF THE CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT FOR A HISTORIC DISTRICT NOMINATION TO THE NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES AND DISTRICT DESIGN GUIDELINES GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting of April 20, 2004, the San Juan Bautista City Council adopted Ordinance 2004-01 Historic Preservation Ordinance, which established the powers and duties of the Historic Resources Board (Board); and

WHEREAS, prescribed duties of the Board are to investigate and report to the City Council on federal, state, local and private funding sources and methods available to promote historic resource preservation; with the approval of the City Council seek public and private funds to preserve historic resources and otherwise seek to involve public and private groups in the preservation of historic resources; and to take a leadership role in the historical and cultural interests of the City of San Juan Bautista in cooperation with the public to strengthen broad community participation in local historical and cultural endeavors; and

WHEREAS, this process, as well as other proactive historic preservation programs set forth in the City's Historic Plan, require both time and resources; and

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2005, the City of San Juan Bautista received Certified Local Government (CLG) status from the State Office of Historic Preservation and can now apply for funding for a variety of activities that relate to furthering historic preservation efforts in a community; and

WHEREAS, in September 2006, a City of San Juan Bautista 2005-2006 Certified Local Government Grant Historical Resources Inventory and Context Statement was prepared, which included a recommendation for the nomination and listing on the National Register of Historical Places of a San Juan Bautista Third Street Historic District; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Resources Board members have prepared application materials requesting funding assistance to prepare a Third Street Historic District Nomination to the National Register of Historic Places and District Design Guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council hereby:

1. Approves the filing of an application for the Certified Local Government Historic Preservation Grant; and
2. Appoints the City Manager or authorized deputy as agent of the city to coordinate, process, and execute all contracts, agreements, amendments, and ancillary documents within the scope of the attached application for certification.
