

**RESOLUTION 2006-14**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF SAN JUAN BAUTISTA IN SUPPPORT OF THE  
VALLEY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY EAST WEST  
CORRIDOR PROPOSAL**

**WHEREAS**, the Valley Transportation Authority has developed a plan for an alternative route to replace the existing Highways 25, 152 and 156; and,

**WHEREAS**, this route would dramatically improve the congestion of these separate highways with a one 4-6 lane freeway from the corner of San Felipe Road and Highway 156 to Highway 101, south of the existing Highway 25; and,

**WHEREAS**, this plan would not only improve the flow of traffic on these three highways and provide a safe alternative, it would also eliminate the need to take 2/3 of the land needed for the currently proposed improvements to the existing highways.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY  
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JUAN BAUTISTA HEREBY  
SUPPORTS THE VALLEY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY'S
