

## RESOLUTION 2006-25

**A Resolution of the City Council of the City of San Juan Bautista specifying the Offices to be filled by the General Municipal Election to be held November 7, 2006, adding two questions to be submitted to the electors of the City of San Juan Bautista changing the elective positions of City Clerk and City Treasurer to Appointive Positions, and requesting the San Benito County Board of Supervisors permit the San Benito County Clerk to provide services for said election of the City of San Juan Bautista**

**Whereas**, the terms of three members of the City Council of the City of San Juan Bautista, namely Priscilla Hill, Charles Geiger, and Arturo Medina will expire at the regular City Council meeting on November 21, 2006 following the General Municipal Election, providing their Successors are elected and qualified; and

**Whereas**, for the purpose of filling said offices, it is necessary that a General Municipal Election be held pursuant to General Law, and other pertinent laws of the State of California; and

**Whereas**, at its regular meeting of May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2006, the City Council voted, pursuant to the authority conferred by California Government Code section 36508, to place two additional questions on the ballot to be posed to the electors of the City of San Juan Bautista at the consolidated General Municipal election to be held November 7<sup>th</sup>, 2006: 1) Shall the previously elective office of City Clerk henceforth be appointed by the City Council? 2) Shall the previously elective office of City Treasurer henceforth be appointed by the City Council?

**Therefore**, be it resolved that the City Council of the City of San Juan Bautista hereby requests that the San Benito County Board of Supervisors permit the San Benito County Clerk to render services in all phases relating to the conduct of the General Municipal Election to be held November 7, 2006. Be it further resolved that the City Council hereby requests that the San Benito County Clerk add two questions to be put to the electors of the City of San Juan Bautista on the November 7th, 2006 ballot: 1) Shall the previously elective office of City Clerk henceforth be appointed by the City Council? 2) Shall the previously elective office of City Treasurer henceforth be appointed by the City Council?
