

RESOLUTION 2006-38

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JUAN
BAUTISTA ACCEPTING THE SPEED ZONE SURVEY STUDY**

WHEREAS, the City of San Juan Bautista employed Pinnacle Traffic Engineering to conduct a speed zone survey study to document existing conditions and provide the appropriate data needed to establish speed zones on various streets within the City, and

WHEREAS, the speed zone survey study was conducted for portions of First Street, Third Street, Fourth Street and Muckelemi Street, and

WHEREAS, it was found that speeds on First Street, Fourth Street and Muckelemi Street were found to be consistent with the posted speed, and

WHEREAS, it was found that speeds on Third Street exceeded the posted speed.

Now, therefore be it resolved that the City Council of the City of San Juan Bautista accepts the traffic report conducted by Pinnacle Traffic Engineering, and

Be it further resolved that the City Council of the City of San Juan Bautista accepts the recommendation of the report to lower the posted speed to 20 miles per hour on Third Street.
