

RESOLUTION 2006-44

A Resolution of the City Council of the City of San Juan Bautista Establishing a Meeting Time for Regularly-Scheduled City Council Meetings

Whereas, section 54954 of the California Government Code requires that the City Council of general law cities such as the City of San Juan Bautista shall provide, by Ordinance, Resolution, bylaws or by whatever other rule is required for the conduct of business by the body, the time and place for holding regular meetings; and

Whereas, by Ordinance 2006-08, introduced May 16th, 2006 and adopted at the regular meeting held on June 20th, 2006, the City Council provided that the time of each monthly regular meeting shall be established from time to time by the City Council via Resolution; and

Whereas, the City Council wishes to provide a meeting time that is both convenient for members of the public and allows full civic participation while at the same time allowing for the conclusion of public business at a reasonable hour;

Now therefore, be it resolved that the City Council of the City of San Juan Bautista clarifies that the regular start time for the study session is **5pm** as the regular start time for a workshop, 6pm for closed sessions and 6:30pm as the start time for the regularly scheduled meetings of the City Council, which meetings shall be held, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 2-1-100 of Title II of the San Juan Bautista Municipal Code, on the third Tuesday of each month at City Hall or such other public facility within the corporate limits of the City deemed by the City Council to be appropriate and convenient for the conducting of such meetings.
