

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-05

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF SAN JUAN BAUTISTA
DESIGNATING AS STOP INTERSECTIONS
BOTH DIRECTIONS ON THE ALAMEDA AT
ITS INTERSECTION WITH PEARCE STREET**

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 21101(b), City is authorized to designate by resolution any intersections within the City as stop intersections and may require vehicles to stop upon installation of appropriate stop signs; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds that The Alameda is a through highway; and

WHEREAS, at its intersection at and through Pearce Street (a three way intersection, as Pearce terminates at The Alameda) this Council finds that designating stops on The Alameda in both directions advances the public health, safety, and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JUAN BAUTISTA DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The following intersections are designated as stop intersections pursuant to Vehicle Code Section 21101(b): The Alameda at Pearce, both directions.

SECTION 2. The City Manager shall cause to be installed required stop signage at said intersections.

SECTION 3. All vehicles shall be required to stop at said intersections.
