A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JUAN BAUTISTA ADOPTING THE SAN BENITO COUNTY BIKEWAY AND PEDESTRIAN MASTER PLAN AND THE MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE BIKEWAY AND PEDESTRIAN MASTER PLAN AS ADOPTED BY SAN BENITO COUNTY COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS RESOLUTION No. 10-4

WHEREAS, the San Benito County Council of Governments has by approval of San Benito County Council of Governments Resolution No. 10-4 adopted the San Benito County Bikeway and Pedestrian Master Plan and the Mitigated Negative Declaration for said Bikeway and Pedestrian Master Plan, and

WHEREAS, the City of San Juan Bautista is a member of the San Benito County Council of Governments and has participated in the development of the Bikeway and Pedestrian Master Plan, the Initial Environmental Impact Study, and supported the Mitigated Negative Declaration, and

WHEREAS, the San Benito County Bikeway and Pedestrian Master Plan will benefit the City of San Juan Bautista and its residents by providing access to State of California Bicycle funds, and the construction of a bikeway from San Juan Bautista to Anzar High School, improvements for Safe Routes to School, as well as connectivity to regional pedestrian facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of San Juan Bautista, California supports the San Benito County Bikeway and Pedestrian Master Plan and does hereby adopt this Resolution of the City Council.
