**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN JUAN BAUTISTA AUTHOIZING THE PURCHASE OF
A NEW SHERIFF'S PATROL VEHICLE**

WHEREAS, the City of San Juan Bautista has a current contract for law enforcement services with the County of San Benito; and

WHEREAS, said contract requires the City to periodically replace the patrol vehicle used by the Sheriff's Department to provide services to the City of San Juan Bautista; and

WHEREAS, the patrol vehicle currently in use has 85,000 miles on it and should be replaced; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of a new vehicle was addressed in the law enforcement portion of the City's FY 2009/10 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council for the City of San Juan Bautista approves an appropriation in an amount not to exceed \$28,000 for the purchase of a patrol vehicle that will meet the specifications of the Sheriff's Department, and authorizes the City Manager to take such actions as may be necessary to conclude the purchase and delivery of the vehicle.
