A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JUAN BAUTISTA
DESIGNATING A SAFE SURRENDER SITE IN THE CITY OF SAN JUAN BAUTISTA

WHEREAS, California's Safely Surrendered Baby Law (SB1368) went into effect on January 1, 2001; and,

WHEREAS, SB1368 was chaptered in the California Health and Safety Code, Section 1255.7; and,

WHEREAS, the Safely Surrendered Baby Law allows a parent or other person who has lawful custody of a baby to surrender that baby, up to 72 hours old, without criminal prosecution for abandonment, provided that there is no suspicion of abuse or neglect; and,

WHEREAS, newborns may be surrendered to any employee on duty at a public or private hospital emergency room or any designated fire station;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council for the City of San Juan Bautista hereby designates the following Safe Surrender Site:

San Juan Bautista Fire Station, 24 Polk Street, San Juan Bautista, California
