

RESOLUTION 2014-33

A RESOLUTION OF APPLICATION OF THE CITY OF SAN JUAN BAUTISTA
INITATING PROCEEDINGS FOR CITY AND CEMETERY PROPERTY
ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF SAN JUAN BAUTISTA

WHEREAS, the City of San Juan Bautista desires to initiate a proceeding for the adjustment of boundaries specified herein.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of San Juan Bautista does hereby order as follows;

1. This proposal is made, and it is requested that proceedings be taken, pursuant to the Cortese/Knox/Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000, commencing with Section 56000 of the California Government Code.
2. This proposal is an annexation to the City of San Juan Bautista.
3. A map of the affected territories is set forth in Exhibit A, B and C, attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein.
4. It is desired that the proposal be subject to the following terms and conditions;
 - a. That the property 012-19-038 and 012-14-027 be zoned public district upon annexation.
 - b. That the property 012-20-001 be zoned quasi public district upon annexation.
5. The reasons for the proposal is to bring City owned Well No. 3 and City owned water reservoir into the City limits to eliminate property tax and allow development of a water facilities on said properties. Reason for annexing the westerly portion of the Cemetery is to eliminate the duplication of law enforcement services on said property.
6. The proposal is consistent with the Sphere of Influence of the City of San Juan Bautista.
7. Consent is hereby given to the waiver of conducting authority proceedings.
