

RESOLUTION 2014-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SAN JUAN BAUTISTA RECOMMENDING AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 11.10 OF THE SAN JUAN BAUTISTA MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has reviewed the Sign Ordinance and has found it to be too restrictive and not friendly to City businesses, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission feels the sign code should be restrictive only when addressing issues of public health and safety, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held public hearings on November 5, 2013, January 23, 2014, and February 4, 2014 where public input was received about the sign ordinance; and

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearings were published in accordance with applicable law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Planning Commission of the City of San Juan Bautista that it recommends to the City Council the amendments to Chapter 11.10 set out in the draft ordinance sent herewith to the Council.
