

**RESOLUTION 2015-04**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SAN JUAN BAUTISTA RECOMMENDING AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 11.10 OF THE SAN JUAN BAUTISTA MUNICIPAL CODE**

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission has reviewed the Sign Ordinance and has found it to be too restrictive and not friendly to City businesses, and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission feels the sign code should be restrictive only when addressing issues of public health and safety, and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission held public hearings on November 5, 2013, January 23, 2014, and February 4, 2014 where public input was received about the sign ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, notice of the public hearings were published in accordance with applicable law.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Planning Commission of the City of San Juan Bautista hereby recommends to the City Council the amendment of Chapter 11.10 Signs of the San Juan Bautista Municipal Code.
