**A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF SAN JUAN BAUTISTA RECOGNIZING THE ANGELINA ALICIA
SANTANA TRUST DURING NATIONAL PRESERVATION MONTH
AND RECOMMEND TO THE CITY COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, the month of May is National Preservation Month, and historic preservation is an effective tool for managing growth and sustainable development, revitalizing neighborhoods, fostering local pride, and maintaining community character while enhancing livability, and

WHEREAS, the City of San Juan Bautista supports the Secretary of the Interior’s Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties, “intended to promote responsible preservation practices that help protect our Nation’s irreplaceable cultural resources,” and

WHEREAS, the function of the Planning Commission is to guide the orderly development of the City in accordance with the General Plan and other policy documents, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission wishes to recognize a business owner whose project reflects the City’s goals to maintain its historical ambiance by preserving and rehabilitating the structure at 36 Washington Street:

- Using a lively and well-coordinated palette of four colors to accentuate the architectural features of the Western false front façade
- Extending the economic life of the building by replacing the roof
- Revitalizing and energizing part of a downtown block that sustained a fire in 2013
- Modeling responsible stewardship of an historic building

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, at its meeting on May 5, 2015, the Planning Commission of the City of San Juan Bautista, on behalf of its citizens, acted to recognize the efforts of the Angelina Alicia Santana Trust in renewing an existing resource at 36 Washington Street (part of the Jardines Restaurant property) and energizing the local economy, and thanks them for being involved citizens.
