**A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SAN JUAN BAUTISTA APPROVING THE DESIGN CONCEPT AND LOCATION OF THE MONUMENT SIGN AT THE CORNER OF NYLAND DRIVE WITH THE ALAMEDA**

**WHEREAS**, the San Juan Committee has been instrumental in obtaining the necessary funding for the construction of a monument sign at the entrance to the San Juan Downtown Historic District, and

**WHEREAS**, the San Juan Committee has prepared preliminary drawings and site plans showing the location and size of the proposed monument sign, and

**WHEREAS**, the San Juan Committee has solicited input from the community, residents, merchants and public representatives on the preliminary design concepts, and

**WHEREAS**, the site location and design of the monument sign will provide visual identification to tourists, visitors and travelers along State Route 156 of the San Juan Bautista Historic District, Mission, State Park and early California architecture.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Planning Commission of the City of San Juan Bautista does hereby approve the preliminary design concept and site location for the proposed monument sign at the southeast corner of Nyland Drive and The Alameda.
